As someone who has attended youth retreats at Gravatt, have you ever wanted to be part of the leadership team who puts together those events?

If so, we invite you to apply to be on the design team for our 5th Grade Retreat. The retreat will be Saturday, April 25th Sunday, April 26th. Design team members must be able to attend the full weekend as well as two design team meetings at All Saints' Episcopal Church in Clinton, SC. The first meeting is Sunday, March 24, 2- 4 pm. The second meeting is Sunday, April 12, 2-4 pm. **(These dates may change to Saturday instead of Sunday if needed.)**

The design team will be made up of young people and adults from throughout the diocese. It is a great stepping stone for those who are interested in serving on DYLC in the future. Design Team members will design all aspects of the weekend from the schedule, worship, talks, games, free time, etc. Design Team members will be expected to work between meetings by preparing talks, small group questions, small group assignments, cruising schedule, cabin assignments, etc. Design Team members also agree to be role models throughout the weekend and to abide by the New 2019 Youth Community Covenant.

The objective of the 5th Grade Bridge Retreat is to give 5th graders a Gravatt experience before they enter youth group. The retreat will allow them to experience a shorter version of a youth retreat with children their own age. The transition from 5th to 6th grade is often a time filled with excitement and anxiety. The trait that most accurately zeros in on fifth-graders' identity is that they are "inbetweeners." Even at church, fifth-graders often feel as if they don't belong. Many think they're too old for Sunday school but are intimidated by junior high kids. This retreat provides a safe environment to meet others who are experiencing the same feelings while experiencing Christ's presence in the community and opening their eyes to Christ's presence in and around them.
