THE STANDING COMMITTEE

The Standing Committee serves as the interim legislative body between Diocesan Conventions. In consultation with the Bishop, the Standing Committee sets Diocesan policy and oversees the property and finances of the Diocese. In addition, the Standing Committee has a role to play in the approval of individuals for ordination and becomes the Ecclesiastical Authority in the absence of a Diocesan Bishop. The members of the Standing Committee also serve on Diocesan Executive Council (DEC) by virtue of their office.

The Standing Committee:

- Embraces and helps promote the diocesan vision;
- Members have church or community experiences relevant to diocesan initiatives;
- Seeks a balance of membership, particularly in geographic and church-size representation;
- Seeks to expand leadership opportunities for diocesan-wide ministry as extensively as possible, therefore, the candidacy of spouses and immediate family members of clergy, and immediate family members of present Council members is discouraged.

Applicants for Standing Committee must submit answers to the following questions with their nomination:

- 1. Provide specific leadership roles you currently hold and describe important insight from these experiences;
- 2. List specific skills that you will bring to the Standing Committee;
- 3. As clergy or a communicant in The Episcopal Diocese of Upper South Carolina, which diocesan initiatives do you have passion for and why?

Standing Committee members are required to:

- 1. **Attend the Orientation and Planning weekend** Friday, December 13 Saturday, December 14, 2024, Location: Gravatt Camp and Conference Center, Aiken, SC;
- 2. **Attend quarterly meetings** The Standing Committee and DEC meet on the same Saturdays in March, June, September, and December, with DEC meeting at 10:00 am and Standing Committee at 1:00 pm.
- 3. **Serve as liaisons to diocesan commissions**, which also meet quarterly.

THE DISCIPLINARY BOARD

The Disciplinary Board consists of four clergy members and three lay members who serve rotating four-year terms. The Disciplinary Board convenes when it is necessary to consider cases of clergy misconduct under Title IV of the Canons of The Episcopal Church.
